GENERAL MANDATE TO ISSUE SHARES

The Company's existing mandate to issue Shares was approved by its then Shareholders on 18 August 2020. Unless otherwise renewed, the existing mandate to issue Shares will lapse at the conclusion of the AGM. At the AGM, an ordinary resolution will be proposed to grant to the Directors a general and unconditional mandate to allot, issue and otherwise deal with Shares of up to 20% of the total number of Shares in issue as at the date of passing of the proposed resolution.

LETTER FROM THE BOARD

In addition, a separate ordinary resolution will be proposed at the AGM to add to the Issue Mandate those Shares repurchased by the Company pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate (if so granted to the Directors at the AGM).

The Directors have no present intention to exercise the Issue Mandate or the Repurchase Mandate (if granted to the Directors at the AGM).

GENERAL MANDATE TO REPURCHASE SHARES

The Company’s existing mandate to repurchase Shares was approved by its then Shareholders on 18 August 2020. Unless otherwise renewed, the existing mandate to repurchase Shares will lapse at the conclusion of the AGM.

For appointment of Mr. Liu Chengwei as an independent non-executive Director, the nomination committee has selected Mr. Liu as a candidate for independent non-executive Director in accordance with the criteria set out in the director nomination policy and the board diversity policy adopted by the Company. The nomination committee is of the view that, as set out in his biographical details, Mr. Liu will bring his legal experience and perspective to the Board, and that his role as an independent non-executive Director will help to improve the operational efficiency of the Board and will be able to provide valuable legal and compliance advice to the Company.

The Board considers that Mr. Li Zhongfei has satisfactorily discharged his duties since his appointment and believes the re-appointment of Mr. Li Zhongfei and the appointment of Mr. Liu Chengwei as independent non-executive Directors at the AGM would promote diversity of the Board in skills and experience.

Details of the above retiring Directors who are subject to re-election at the AGM and Mr. Liu Chengwei, the proposed Director, are set out in Appendix II to this circular in accordance with the relevant requirements of the GEM Listing Rules.

She was an editor for CCTV-2 (Business Channel) from May 2012 to July 2014.

Ms. Song is a younger sister of Mr. Song Xiaoming, an executive Director and the chairman of the Board.

Ms. Song has entered into a service agreement with the Company as an executive Director for a fixed term of three years commencing from 25 August 2020, and she is not entitled to any director’s fee.

Ms. Lin Shuxian (林淑嫻)

Ms. Lin Shuxian (“**Ms. Lin**”), aged 39, was appointed as an executive Director on 12 July 2018. She is also a director of certain subsidiaries of the Company. She is the deputy investment director of the Investment Department at Great Walle Investment. From November 2007 to May 2009, Ms. Lin was the financial analyst at the Business Valuation Department of Shenzhen Branch, Jones Lang LaSalle Sallmanns (Beijing) Consultants Limited* (仲量聯行西門(北京)諮詢有限公司深圳分公司) (currently renamed as Shenzhen Branch, Jones Lang LaSalle (Beijing) Consultants Limited* (仲量聯行(北京)諮詢有限公司深圳分公司)).
