 - A member entitled to attend and vote at the Meeting is entitled to appoint one or more than one proxy to attend and vote in his/her stead. A proxy need not be a member of the Company. If more than one proxy is so appointed, the appointment shall specify the number of Shares in respect of which each such proxy is so appointed.
 - In order to be valid, the form of proxy must be deposited at the Company’s Hong Kong branch share registrar, Tricor Secretaries Limited, at 17/F., Far East Finance Centre, 16 Harcourt Road, Hong Kong together with a power of attorney or other authority, if any, under which it is signed or a notarially certified copy of that power or authority, not less than 48 hours before the time appointed for holding the Meeting (i.e. 11:00 a.m. on 25 June 2024 (Tuesday)) (the “Closing Time”) or adjourned meeting.
 - No instrument appointing a proxy shall be valid after expiration of 12 months from the date named in it as the date of its execution, except at an adjourned meeting or on a poll demanded at the Meeting or any adjournment thereof in cases where the Meeting was originally held within 12 months from such date.
 - Where there are joint holders of any Shares, any one of such joint holder may vote at the Meeting, either in person or by proxy, in respect of such share as if he/she were solely entitled thereto, but if more than one of such joint holders be present at the Meeting, the vote of the senior who tenders a vote, whether in person or by proxy, shall be accepted to the exclusion of the votes of the other joint holders, and for this purpose, seniority shall be determined by the order in which the names stand in the Register of Members of the Company in respect of the joint holding.
 - Reference is made to the announcement of the Company dated 7 June 2024, as Baker Tilly Hong Kong Limited will retire at the conclusion of the Meeting upon expiration of its current term of office, and will not be re-appointed, ordinary resolution no. 3 as set out in the Original Notice should be deleted in its entirety.
 - This form of proxy contains revisions to the original form of proxy (“Original Proxy Form”) sent together with the circular of the Company dated 19 April 2024. If you have lodged the Original Proxy Form in accordance with the instructions printed thereon, please note that:
 - Subject to (iii) below, if this form of proxy is not lodged, the Original Proxy Form will be treated as a valid form of proxy lodged by you if duly completed and signed. The proxy appointed under the Original Proxy Form will also be entitled to vote in accordance with the instructions previously given by you or at his/her/its discretion (if no such instructions are given) on any resolutions properly put to the Meeting (including the proposed resolution set out above which are in addition to those set out in Original Proxy Form).
 - If this form of proxy is lodged at or before the Closing Time in accordance with the instructions printed thereon, this form of proxy will be treated as a valid form of proxy lodged by you if duly completed and signed, and will revoke and supersede the Original Proxy Form previously lodged.
 - If this form of proxy is lodged after the Closing Time, this form of proxy will be deemed invalid. It will not revoke the Original Proxy Form previously lodged. The Original Proxy Form will be treated as a valid form of proxy lodged by you if duly completed and signed. The proxy appointed under the Original Proxy Form will be entitled to vote in the manner as mentioned in (i) above as if you have not lodged this form of proxy.
