## PROPOSED SHARE CONSOLIDATION

#### PROPOSED SHARE CONSOLIDATION

The Board proposes to implement the Share Consolidation on the basis that every twenty (20) issued and unissued Existing Shares of HK\$0.1 each in the share capital of the Company be consolidated into one (1) Consolidated Share of HK\$2.0 each.

As at the date of this announcement, the Existing Shares are traded on the Stock Exchange in the board lot size of 2,000 Existing Shares. Upon the Share Consolidation becoming effective, the board lot size for trading in the Consolidated Shares will remain unchanged at 2,000 Consolidated Shares. Based on the closing price of HK\$0.08 per Existing Share (equivalent to HK\$1.6 per Consolidated Share) as quoted on the Stock Exchange as at the date of this announcement, the market value of each board lot of 2,000 Consolidated Shares, assuming the Share Consolidation had become effective, would be HK\$3,200.

#### **GENERAL**

The EGM will be convened and held for the Shareholders to consider and, if thought fit, approve the Share Consolidation. A circular containing, among other things, further detail of the proposed Share Consolidation and the notice convening the EGM will be despatched to the Shareholders in due course.

Shareholders should take note that the Share Consolidation is conditional upon the fulfilment of its conditions. Therefore, the Share Consolidation may or may not proceed. Shareholders and potential investors are advised to exercise caution when dealing in the securities of the Company, and if they are in any doubt about their position, they should consult their professional advisers.

#### PROPOSED SHARE CONSOLIDATION

The Board proposes to implement the Share Consolidation on the basis that every twenty (20) issued and unissued Existing Shares of HK\$0.1 each in the share capital of the Company be consolidated into one (1) Consolidated Share of HK\$2.0 each.

#### Effects of the Share Consolidation

As at the date of this announcement, the authorised share capital of the Company is HK\$800,000,000, divided into 8,000,000,000 Existing Shares of HK\$0.1 each, of which 757,828,571 Existing Shares have been issued and are fully paid or credited as fully paid.

Immediately upon the Share Consolidation becoming effective and assuming there will be no change in the issued share capital of the Company from the date of this announcement and up to the effective date of the Share Consolidation, the authorised share capital of the Company shall be HK\$800,000,000, divided into 400,000,000 Consolidated Shares of HK\$2.0 each, of which 37,891,428 Consolidated Shares will be in issue.

Upon the Share Consolidation becoming effective, the Consolidated Shares shall rank pari passu in all respects with each other in the same class.

Other than the expenses to be incurred in relation to the Share Consolidation, the implementation of the Share Consolidation will not alter the underlying assets, business operations, management or financial position of the Company or the proportionate interests or rights of the Shareholders. The Board believes that the Share Consolidation will not have any material adverse effect on the financial position of the Company.

# Outstanding options, warrants or other securities

As at the date of this announcement, the Company does not have any outstanding options, warrants or other securities in issue which are convertible or exchangeable into the Existing Shares.

#### **Conditions of the Share Consolidation**

The implementation of the Share Consolidation is conditional upon the fulfilment of the following:

- (i) the passing of an ordinary resolution by the Shareholders at the EGM to approve the Share Consolidation;
- (ii) the Stock Exchange granting the listing of, and permission to deal in, the Consolidated Shares in issue and to be issued upon the Share Consolidation becoming effective; and

(iii) the compliance with all relevant procedures and requirements under the applicable laws of the Cayman Islands and the GEM Listing Rules to effect the Share Consolidation.

# **Listing Application**

An application will be made by the Company to the Stock Exchange for the listing of, and permission to deal in, the Consolidated Shares in issue and to be issued upon the Share Consolidation becoming effective.

Subject to the granting of the listing of, and permission to deal in, the Consolidated Shares on the Stock Exchange, as well as compliance with the stock admission requirements of the HKSCC, upon the Share Consolidation being effective, the Consolidated Shares will be accepted as eligible securities by HKSCC for deposit, clearance and settlement in CCASS with effect from the commencement date of dealings in the Consolidated Shares on the Stock Exchange or such other date as determined by HKSCC. Settlement of transactions between participants of the Stock Exchange on any trading day is required to take place in CCASS on the second settlement day thereafter. All activities under CCASS are subject to the General Rules of CCASS and CCASS Operational Procedures in effect from time to time. All necessary arrangements will be made for the Consolidated Shares to be admitted into CCASS established and operated by HKSCC.

None of the Existing Shares are listed or dealt on any other stock exchange other than the Stock Exchange, and at the time the Share Consolidation becomes effective, the Consolidated Shares in issue will not be listed or dealt on any stock exchange other than the Stock Exchange, and no such listing or permission to deal is being or is proposed to be sought.

#### REASONS FOR THE SHARE CONSOLIDATION

Pursuant to Rule 17.76 of the GEM Listing Rules, where the market price of the securities of an issuer approaches the extremities of HK\$0.01 or HK\$9,995.00, the issuer may be required either to change the trading method or to proceed with a consolidation or splitting of its securities. The Guide on Trading Arrangements has further stated that (i) market price of the Shares at a level less than HK\$0.1 each will be considered as trading at extremity as referred to under Rule 17.76 of the GEM Listing Rules; and (ii) taking into account the minimum transaction costs for a securities trade, the expected value per board lot should be greater than HK\$2,000.

Based on the closing price of HK\$0.08 per Existing Share as at the date of this announcement, and the board lot size of 2,000 Existing Share, the board lot value of Existing Shares is HK\$160, which is lower than HK\$2,000. After the Share Consolidation becoming effective, the estimated board lot value of the Consolidated Shares will be HK\$3,200. As such, the Share Consolidation will enable the Company to comply with the trading requirements under the GEM Listing Rules and reduce the overall transaction and handling costs of dealings in the Shares as a proportion of the market value of each board lot, since most of the banks or securities houses will charge a minimum transaction costs for each securities trade. In addition, the Board considers that the corresponding upward adjustment in the trading price per Consolidated Share as a result of the Share Consolidation will make investing in the shares of the Company more attractive to a broader range of investors, and thus further broaden the shareholder base of the Company.

The Company believes the Share Consolidation will not have any material adverse effect on the financial position of the Company nor result in change in the relative rights of the Shareholders.

In view of the above reasons, the Company is of the view that the Share Consolidation is beneficial to and in the interests of the Company and the Shareholders as a whole.

As at the date of this announcement, the Company has no concrete plans to carry out other corporate actions or conduct any equity fundraising which may have an effect of undermining or negating the intended purpose of the Share Consolidation in the next 12 months. However, the Directors will not rule out any fundraising activities they may consider when it is reasonably necessary for the Group to raise fund to meet its operational needs or for future development. The Directors will carefully consider the likely impact on the Shareholders before they will proceed on any fundraising exercises and make further announcement(s) in this regard in accordance with the Listing Rules as and when appropriate.

#### NO CHANGE IN BOARD LOT SIZE

As at the date of this announcement, the Existing Shares are traded on the Stock Exchange in the board lot size of 2,000 Existing Shares. Upon the Share Consolidation becoming effective, the board lot size for trading in the Consolidated Shares will remain unchanged at 2,000 Consolidated Shares. Based on the closing price of HK\$0.08 per Existing Share (equivalent to HK\$1.6 per Consolidated Share) as quoted on the Stock Exchange as at the date of this announcement, the market value of each board lot of 2,000 Consolidated Shares, assuming the Share Consolidation had become effective, would be HK\$3,200.

#### OTHER ARRANGEMENTS

#### Fractional entitlement to Consolidated Shares

Fractional Consolidated Shares, arising from the Share Consolidation (if any) will be disregarded and will not be issued to the Shareholders but all such fractional Consolidated Shares will be aggregated and, if possible, sold for the benefit of the Company. Fractional Consolidated Shares will only arise in respect of the entire shareholding of a holder of the Existing Shares regardless of the number of share certificates held by such holder.

## Arrangement on odd lot trading

In order to facilitate the trading of odd lots (if any) of the Consolidated Shares, the Company will appoint a securities firm as an agent to provide matching services, on a best effort basis, to those Shareholders who wish to acquire odd lots of the Consolidated Shares to make up a full board lot, or to dispose of their holding of odd lots of the Consolidated Shares. Details of the odd lot arrangement will be set out in the circular to be despatched to the Shareholders.

Holders of odd lots of the Consolidated Shares should note that the matching of the sale and purchase of odd lots of the Consolidated Shares is not guaranteed. Shareholders who are in any doubt about the odd lots matching arrangement are recommended to consult their own professional advisers.
